In the early summer of 1944 the Me 262 became the world's first operational jet aircraft. With a top speed of 540 m.p.h. it easily outperformed any Allied aircraft of WWII, and went on to revolutionize aerial warfare. A truly remarkable aircraft. White 5 of 1/KG (J) 54 was based at Giebelstadt, Würzburg, January 1945.
